Year 3 & 4 and 5 & 6 Level 2 Sportshall Athletics Competition 2022/23

The aim of this competition is to provide your pupils with the opportunity to compete in Sportshall Athletics against other schools. We hope that your pupils will enjoy this competition and are then given the opportunity to join local Crewe and Nantwich Athletic Club. For more information about this club please visit their website www.creweandnantwichac.org.uk. In addition to the local club please find enclosed a flyer for a community athletics session.

Following the break last year we are once again including a year 3&4 format as part of this event. The format will only work with the support of all schools entering both year 3&4 and year 5&6 teams. The year 3&4 format is very similar to the year 5&6 format. Please see * below for difference between year 3&4 and 5&6 and also slight change in two events for both.

There are 7 heats this year, all taking place within a 2 week period. Both the year 3&4 and year 5&6 winner of each heat will qualify for a 7 team Final.

Please refer to the information below when selecting your teams and also the attached running order and team sheets.

- Please ensure you use the right running order and team sheet.
- There are specific running orders/team sheets for the rural (small schools), heat 1, and the
 urban, heats 2 7. On the team sheets you will find guidance on the minimum and
 maximum number of pupils and how many events they can take part in.
- Heat 1 (rural) includes a minimum of 6 girls and 6 boys and a maximum of 9 girls and 9 boys.
- Heats 2 7 includes a minimum of 9 girls and 9 boys and a maximum of 15 girls and 15 boys.
- Please make sure you have fully completed your team sheets prior to attending and have a spare copy to hand in on arrival.

*Difference in year 3&4 format:

- Instead of the Standing Triple Jump there will be <u>3 Bounds/Strides</u> (please note this has been changed from previous 5 bounds). This will involve each child performing 3 bounds/strides on a roll out measuring matt.
- Instead of the 6 lap paarlauf children will take part in a <u>scored hurdles relay race</u> (please note this has changed from the non-scoring Speed Bounce event). Full instructions and a demonstration will be given at the event.

*For both year 3&4 and 5&6 events there will no longer be a requirement for children to undertake a forward roll or any kind of roll in both the obstacle relay and the over and under races. Instead, a bean bag or foam relay baton will be used so children will have to pass to the next runner.

* Please also bear in mind that the start line for the obstacle relay and the over and under races will be in a slightly different place to previous years e.g. it will be further away from the turn board – this will be fully explained at the beginning of each race.
